Prof. Onyemaechi Valentine “Val” Ekechukwu is a Nigerian academic and Professor of Mechanical Engineering (Applied Solar Energy). He earned his PhD in Mechanical Engineering (Applied Energy) from Cranfield University, United Kingdom, in 1988.

He has been a Professor of Applied Solar Energy in the Department of Mechanical Engineering at the University of Nigeria, Nsukka (UNN) since 2001, where he began his academic career as a Graduate Research Assistant in 1983.

Prof. Ekechukwu served as Director of Research and Innovation and later Director of ICT at the National Universities Commission (NUC) (2007–2015), and was Dean of the Faculty of Engineering at UNN (2018–2020).
